The Society of Family Planning is a community of scholars, clinicians, and partners who share a vision of just and equitable access to abortion and contraception informed by science.

To inform our community's response to the *Dobbs v Jackson Women's Health Organization* Supreme Court decision, we are seeking to understand shifts in how and where people access abortion before and after the decision. The Society of Family Planning is leading the effort to collect data from providers across the country. Aggregate data, by state, will be shared with stakeholders to support policy efforts and strategic planning.

What data are we collecting?

Total number of abortions provided per month.

How can I sign up to participate?

Will we be compensated for our time?

Yes. We will provide up to twelve months of compensation if you are able to continue to provide abortion services.

How long of a commitment is this?

As long as you are providing abortion services, up to twelve months.
